Learn German at the coast!

The best way to learn German is in Germany. That is why Jade University is offering once again "Seaside Summer Course in German" for the 16th consecutive year at the campus in Wilhelmshaven.

Participants live in Wilhelmshaven for a 4-week period in which they improve their language skills in small groups overseen by qualified teachers. Each participant receives a certificate at the end of the course.

The course is particularly suited for those planning to study in Germany but also for anyone who would like to improve their German language skills.

Five hours of lessons take place in small groups each morning. The afternoons are used to put theory into practice. Placement tests are first conducted in order to find the right course for each need.

It is our goal to train the participants' communicative skills: normal, everyday conversations are practiced so that pronunciation can be trained, listening skills improved and correct grammar used. Various cultural topics are worked out in projects or in presentations.

At the end of the course students will not only have deepened their knowledge of Germany and its culture, but also will have become much more competent with German and will have made many new friends!

In addition to the morning language classes, “Seaside Summer Course in German” offers an extensive recreation program as follows:

Course fees

The fee of the course amounts to **€ 499.00** (euros).

The course fees cover the costs of the lessons and the excursions as well as any entrance fees. NOT included are any costs for accommodation and meals. Visiting students from our partner universities intending to register for an upcoming semester in the academic year of 2012/13 will receive a discount for the course.

Accommodation in Wilhelmshaven

After the registration fee has been received, we will be glad to arrange accommodation in a youth hostel in the area. The charge for 4 weeks in a shared room amounts to € 330.00 (29 July - 25 August 2012) per person, including breakfast. The stay may be extended at an additional charge.

Other costs

Each course participant is responsible for her/his own meals for the four-week period. The cost for eating in the university cafeteria usually amounts to about 30-50 euros per week.
