Do you want to make a difference to the world's 'big' issues, like peace, poverty, pollution, economic and environmental crises? Do you want to be a catalyst for change? Or do you want to learn how you can work with the strengths of public and private sectors to make a better world? Answer 'yes' to these questions and summer school could be the next step in your career.

At The Hague Summer School you'll find yourself in a cutting edge and vibrant campus, in the centre of a legal, political and business-orientated city, in the heart of Europe.

Course content
