CREDIT POINTS AND EXAMINATIONS

Our university offers 5 ECTS credit points for attending the SUL. The 5 ECTS are awarded for attendance of the lectures and the company visits as well as for the final exam.

HOUSING

You can choose between two housing options:

Option 1: Shared student apartment

You will be accommodated with other German or international students in student apartments near the campus. Students will have their own bedroom but will usually share a bathroom and a kitchen. The apartments are located throughout the city of Lingen and are not in one building complex. You are responsible for keeping your own room and the common areas (kitchen and bathroom) clean.

Option 2: Find your own housing

You can organize housing for yourself in one of the hotels in Lingen or vacation apartments. After your acceptance to the program, you will receive a list of possible hotels. You are responsible for making your own reservations.

The area of Lingen, where our Summer University takes place, is home to many Mittelstand companies. The companies have strong ties to the region while at the same time operating very successfully on an international and global market. The Summer University Lingen (SUL) will analyze the following questions:

- What is the structure of German economy and what are the challenges?
- What is the German Mittelstand?
- What are the key success factors of family-owned and medium-sized companies? How did they become internationally successful?

Students will attend lectures on topics such as

- Features of small and medium-sized enterprises (SME)
- International Management and International Marketing
- International Human Resource Management
- Technology based SME

Besides the lectures, students will also participate in group and project work as well as deal with case studies.

We will visit several internationally operating companies to gain insight into the regional, international and global procedures of companies in Germany, the city of Lingen and its surrounding area.
