PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The International Summer School will be held in August 2012 in Finland. It is organised by the Information Technology Degree Programme and the Business School of Helsinki Metropolia UAS.

The Summer School offers a great chance to travel abroad, learn new things, meet new people and network internationally – all this at the same time!



COURSE OFFERING



METROPOLIA UAS AND CAMPUS LOCATION

Metropolia has several campuses in Helsinki Metropolitan area but all Summer School courses are held in Leppävaara campus in the city of Espoo. The city centre of Helsinki, the capital of Finland, is only 10 kilometres away. We have a very good transport system in the metropolitan area. For example from Leppävaara station it takes only 12-17 minutes to Helsinki central railway station by commuter train.



COSTS

The courses are a free of charge for students of Metropolia's partner institutions outside Finland. The participants have to pay travel costs to Finland, local transportation, accommodation and subsistence themselves. After you have registered for the courses, we'll send you information about accommodation possibilities for your stay.

For Open University students the study fee is 10 € /credit. Open University students are all students that are not degree students at Metropolia UAS or in a foreign partner institution.

Registration for the courses starts 1 May and ends 24 June 2012.
